

2006-2007 Facility Concept for College Place Middle School

Staff Comments: November 6, 2006

- Create a separate playground for Preschool - 2nd Grade and 3rd – 5th
- Library needs to be even larger to accommodate Davis Library and Meadow Brook
- Original Davis School schematic was approx. 72,000 square feet
- Food Services - How are we going to serve so many students?
- Gym – In place of bleachers, Could there be steps down from the stage to gym (similar to Blue Ridge Elementary in WW)
- Parking – Needs to be addressed
- Traffic Plan – We need one
- Consider placing the older students closer to Meadow Brook (Mr. Deiss)
- Why are the youngest classes/students the farthest from the office? Won't these be kids who will need to be closer the nurse, parent entry points, etc. (Mr. Deiss)
- Consider switching 3rd and 5th grade teachers, then they won't have to move their rooms (Mr. Deiss)
- Meadow Brook = 650 Kids Sager = 375 Kids (Mr. Deiss)
- Stage/Kitchen – Do kids eat in the Stage Area? (Mr. Deiss)
- Consider a Computer Lab in the open area off the Library, with outside entry to Gym (Mr. Deiss)
- GYM - Are they sure it's not a better idea just to “nuke” the gym building? It's such a derelict facility. (Mr. Deiss)
- GYM Classrooms – Will these be renovated for better air circulation? (Mr. Deiss)
- How do you get 487 square feet? Isn't that a prime #? (Mr. Deiss)

- Classroom (5+12=17) – Where is Gear-Up housed? How about the counselor? Where is the Life Skills facility? Where is ISS housed? Will there be a separate ISS room for Meadow Brook & Sager? (Mr. Deiss)
- Meadow Brook - We need another SPED room closer to the 3rd/4th/5th section of the school.
- Meadow Brook - What are the bathrooms sizes? Are the classroom walls brick? Yuck.
- Meadow Brook – Where is the handicap bathroom in the Sped Ed Classroom?
- Gym – Needs to be big enough to accommodate bleachers. Add now or the gym doesn't work later.
- K-1 distance traveled to gym....too far?
- Gym – Where is the storage? Hard wood flooring? Exit doors? Bleachers?
- What if the Bond doesn't pass?
- Where the planned space is for the Science Courtyard – Is it fenced in not apart of the playground?
- Music Classroom – Too loud to be next to a 5th grade classroom
- Gym –Where is the cafeteria? Is there enough room for all parents at Christmas program?
- Are there closets in the classrooms? MB is blessed with big closets – Keep this!
- Do we need another Sped Ed, life skills, and resource room?
- Title – This needs to be a monster to fit all the stuff from MD and Davis! Also – We need room for staff – and to meet w/ kids. Maybe 2 title rooms...1 for stuff, 1 for kids.
- Pre-School – Only one Pre-K classroom? We currently have 1 Pre-K and 1 developmental Pre-K.
- Kindergarten Rooms – Why are they in a row? Consider in a pod?
- Couldn't we build an area that covers the black top (overhang) for rainy day recess instead of spending so much more for a gym?
- Could we combine the schools and make it a K-8 building...It would help unify staff and help specialists. (These buildings are so close anyway.) It could reduce staff?
- Consider a 2nd main entrance?
- Parking – Need more.

- Are there going to be restrooms in all rooms? Need more bathrooms for Pre-K , K, 1st
- Music and Sped Ed classrooms should be more centrally located.
- Library – In the center there is a blind spot?
- Extra parking please. Bus and car loop?
- Pre-K and K need there own bathrooms
- If all classrooms in the K, 1st grade wing had there own bathrooms, then the current restroom space could be used for bigger/extra classroom (copier/storage)
- Need space for students to eat. Cafeteria space?
- Gyms do not have any “people” space to sit on bleachers for games/sports
- Cost Difference? New cost for complete renovation of Sager including District office VS. New cost of Davis School
- Have along term lease with the City of College Place to use Davis as a Community Center
- Do we only have one parking lot?
- “I like it!” Just PLEASE ask for enough \$\$\$\$ so that we don’t cut corners and end up saying “we should have.”
- Maybe consider switching wings so that 5th grade is closer to Middle School – going to High Cap – transitioning
- Consider placing all the 1st grade classrooms closer together so the teachers can easily collaborate
- Would it be better to have the little ones closer to the gym & lunch room?
- Where is the outdoor nature area? (Previously provided by the park next to Davis.)
- Too many kids for the one library
- Where is the cafeteria?
- Bathrooms in K + Primary? (Every class should have a bathroom.)
- No opportunity for WW College students to help!
- This is a very poor site for children. The Davis plan at Davis is a much better plan for our kids and this community.

- **Staff room is not big enough.**
- **Please make sure you talk to Life Skills staff about the room and what it needs to have (i.e. beams, fans, windows, flooring, etc.) before things get started. Also, an outside door so during fire drills we aren't trying to get down the hall with all the other classes.**
- **There is not enough staff parking!**
- **If we move to MB/Sager, what are you doing with Davis land? Sell to recoup \$ for new building, or keep for future high school?**
- **Parking – for staff and large public events (programs, open houses, etc.)**
- **Special Ed Concept: Good sound barriers necessary between Life Skills and Resource Room. Careful consideration must be taken about program needs with those that KNOW. (Specialists: SLP, OT, PT, School Psychologist)**
- **What about spacious work areas for each wing? Will copy machine, laminators, etc. be made available in each major area? Will parking be an issue?**
- **Title + common storage? Will there be adequate space devoted to common storage resources? Davis currently houses Literacy resources (over 20,000 items) +Science + Math in a classroom separate from the Title teaching space.**
- **The coaches feel strongly for the athletic need for the East extra gym attached to the South part of the main Sager Gym. This is needed for several sports and especially for the communities for softball and baseball. In the preliminary plan this is switched to classroom space, therefore this would be a reduction of extra gym/sports space which the gym teachers and coaches would strongly oppose. This area has been used extensively for storage and staging (i.e. track and field, jumping pit, hurdles, etc.); therefore it is extremely important that this area remain off the main Sager Gym.**
- **Two entrances for security (Main office and Gym area)**
- **Lighted parking area and campus**
- **Please provide a small sink in every classroom**
- **More storage in workroom(s)**
- **Gym needs peaked roof**

- **SHOP – Wood Storage, Finish Room, Tool Room?**
- **Where do you foresee classrooms at? Grade levels together?**
- **Upstairs a difficult area – narrow hallways –very dark (skylights?) – Redo bathrooms; Very noisy at times (sound proofing?) – Heating & cooling a problem: windows need to open w/ shades?**
- **FGS Room unsuitable for classroom at this time (NEEDS WINDOWS)**
- **Access to ship? Down hallway...concerns about supervision (windows to classrooms, lighting)**
- **More outlets in ALL GYM ROOMS**
- **Mounted projectors in each room, wired to computers/VCR/DVD, cable, internet, outlets – Computers to TV's TVs to Elmos to properly keyed.**
- **Where is the front door? Traffic flow? Kitchen delivery? Mold...inspection, remove it?!**
- **Does Home Ec Room include classroom area, sewing area and cooking area? Would suggest carpet in classroom area and at least 5-6 cooking labs.**
- **WE NEED MORE GYM SPACE.....let's talk!!!**
- **Outside restrooms for sporting events. City Library for public use? Storage rooms?**
- **Main entrance for Sager needs to be main entrance, closer to parking lot, rather than recesses. Move the whole section of building so it lines up with current gym.**
